My trigger fingers itched. I wanted that cowboy... in ACTION.

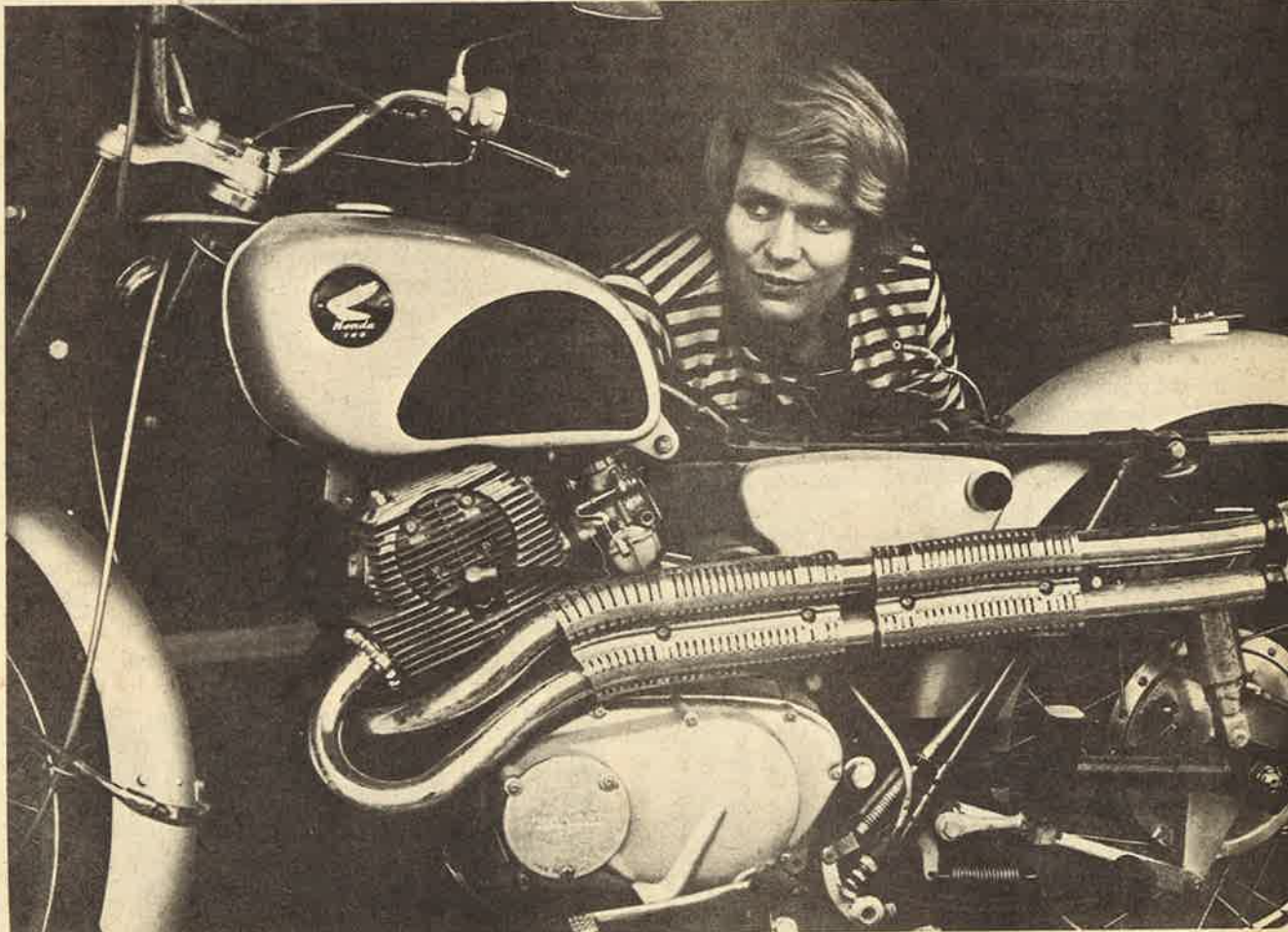
It still didn't start but Mark, undaunted, ran the machine up the street.
